

NATIONAL SEMINAR ON PUPIL EVALUATION

Systematic evaluation of school children is inevitable for assuring learning achievement in accordance with prescribed learning outcomes at school level. The RTE Act, 2009 has mandated Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) at Elementary Stage for ensuring universal attainment of desired learning levels by all elementary school children. Scientific evaluation is necessary not only at the elementary stage, but also at the Secondary and Higher Education stage.

In this context, a two day National Seminar on Pupil Evaluation is going to be organized on January, 29-30, 2019 in Guwahati. This seminar will provide a forum for exchange of views and experiences among educational planners, educationists, teachers, administrators and practitioners and dissemination of research, innovative and developments in the area of teacher education.

THE MAIN OBJECTIVES OF THE SEMINAR WILL BE TO --

- to deliberate on problems and issues related to Pupils Evaluation at school level
- to share findings of empirical researches on different aspects of the present system of pupils' assessment in India/ Assam and effectiveness thereof
- to know about solutions from researchers for making the system of pupil evaluation more effective
- to encourage action oriented research by the practitioners

SUB THEMES :

- Present system of Pupil Evaluation at school level: Problems and Prospects
- Impact of CCE on Learning Outcome
- Role of teachers in assessment process
- Comparative effectiveness of different process of student assessment

INVITATION FOR PAPERS :

Papers are invited from teachers, educationists, teacher educators, administrators, students etc. or any one or a combination of the above mentioned sub-areas. The paper may be based on experimental research work or on case studies or may be a theoretical research paper. The paper should not have been published earlier or communicated to any conference or journal.

LAST DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF PAPER :

Full and final paper not exceeding two thousand five hundred words along with an abstract in about 300 words typed in MS-WORD on A4 size paper (Font name - Times New Roman, Font size-12), in double space should be sent through email to the Seminar Co-ordinator by January, 15, 2019. The authors are requested to send the registration form to the Co-ordinator on or before January 5, 2019.

LANGUAGE OF THE PAPER :

Paper may be written either in English or Assamese.

REGISTRATION :

Registration will be restricted only to the principal paper presenter.

PRESENTATION :

Only the principal author of the selected paper will be invited to make a presentation in the National Seminar and participate in its deliberations.

SEMINAR SUPPORT :

SCERT, Assam will provide local hospitality to only those participants who are invited to present their papers. Participants will have to bear their travel expenses.

CERTIFICATION :

SCERT, Assam will award a certificate of participation and paper presentation.
